Giant Chocolate Chip Cookie for One

Prep Time: 5 minutes | Cook Time: 15 minutes | Total Time: 20 Minutes

Ingredients:

- 2 Tablespoons unsalted butter, softened
- 2 Tablespoons granulated sugar
- 2 Tablespoons light brown sugar, packed
- 2 Tablespoons beaten egg
- 1/2 Teaspoon pure vanilla extract
- 6 Tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 3 Tablespoons instant vanilla pudding
- 1/4 Teaspoon baking soda
- 1/4 Teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/4 cup mini chocolate chips

Directions:

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degree F, and line a large baking sheet with silpat liner, parchment paper, or cooking spray.
- 2. Combine ingredients in the order they are listed making sure everything is combined before you ad the next ingredient. Place dough in the center of a cookie sheet and bake for 15-18 minutes. Let cool and serve at room temperature or warm. Enjoy :)
